

Beginning Ruler Work Class

Please bring the following to class:

- Sewing Machine (preferably with needle up/down and a flat sewing surface) in good working order (cord and foot control)
- Sewing tray or extension table (like the sew steady table)
- Ruler foot that fits your machine (*we have some of the Westalee ruler feet as well as the Bernina ruler foot, if you are not sure what foot you need, let us know and we would be happy to help you*)*
- Top Stitch needles size 12 *
- Every Angle Straight Ruler- either for Long Arm or Low Shank depending on your machine
- Free Motion Glider sheet or Teflon Sheet
- quilting gloves or something similar
- Good quality thread, polyester or cotton*. Any color- except white, natural or black.
- Bobbin filled with same thread as top.
- Fabric marker of your choice
- Quilt Squares to practice Please use good quality, cotton fabric. (See below for instructions)

Before coming to class:

Please have 4 squares -14" X 14"- put together in the following way before coming to class:

Cut 8 14" squares of good quality muslin or a good quality solid (or reads solid) fabric that you already have. Just be sure to bring a contrasting color thread so you can see your stitching.

Cut 4 14" squares of cotton batting

Layer each square with the batting in between 2 squares of muslin. Spray baste with 505 if you have it.

*We have any notions that you might need here at the shop. All students receive a 15% on any class supplies purchased.

Diane, your instructor, will bring an assortment of rulers for you to try during class.
