Bucket Brigade

Shoreline Sewing Heather Botelle - Instructor

In this class we will be using the Bucket Brigade pattern from Atkinsons Designs. The pattern comes with instructions for 4 different sizes, we will be making the medium (10' w x 9" h). If you have not already done so, this is an opportunity to work with Stiff Stuff and Plastic tubing. Both are used to provide structure and the final product is nice and sturdy.

Please bring the following:

- Sewing machine in good working order
- 1/4" quilting foot
- Walking foot
- Rotary cutter
- Matching thread for topstitching
- Chalk or marking pen
- Pins
- Scissors with pointed tip
- Clips may also be helpful (in addition to pins)
- Basting glue stick optional

Fabric you will need:

3/4 yard for the main fabric

3/4 yard for the contrasting fabric

1 1/4 yard Stiff Stuff (20" wide)

- 1 yard of 1/4" plastic tubing
- 1 yard fusible woven interfacing (20" wide)

Optional accent prints if you choose to add a handle:

1 - 2 fat eighths

Prep Work

In order to give us more time to sew and construct the bucket please do the following before coming to the class:

Cut all materials to size using the instructions on page 1 of the pattern. If you do not have the pattern before class please email me and I can send you a picture of this page.

Fuse the woven interfacing to the **wrong** side of both the main and contrasting fabrics. Only the walls and bottoms. Please be sure to protect both your iron and your ironing board when fusing. The bumpy side is the adhesive so this should be facing the wrong side of your fabrics.
